
I received your decision with respect to a citation for an infraction under the CVC 4000 for not having registered my vehicle in California and this infraction was a fix it order by CHP officer who issued ticketed on 24.DEC.2003 #67443 in the city of Chico CA. I had until 22.JAN.2004 to comply with the law. I left California on 30.DEC.2003 and I am currently in Arizona after a brief stay in Nevada.

I am still a Texas resident, I was in Chico attending CSUC as an out of state student when CHP officer issued me the fix it ticket to register my vehicle in California. As I have told him I am going to repeat myself here again, **I DO NOT INTEND TO BECOME A CALIFORNIA RESIDENT, and I AM NOT REGISTERING MY VEHICLE IN CALIFORNIA** until I want to be a resident of California, **NOR AM I PAYING ANY FEES OR PENALTIES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS FREVELOUS CITATION.**

Please excuse the order to registering my vehicle in California since I am a resident of the state of Texas with valid and current registration and insurance where I vote and pay taxes. As a courtesy I am re-sending the original \$10.00 check for the court costs.

In my previous letter I have included copies of bills and CSU Chico registration information to support the fact that I am not a California resident subject to vehicle registration, these papers are on file at the court.
