I am NOT a California resident, I did not move to California, I do not intend to become a California resident until I can afford to by land, build my house and live in California, I am not rich enough to do any of these things. I received a registration ticket while attending CSU Chico as an out of state student. I am a resident of Texas and all of my paperwork, vehicle registration, drivers license, motor home insurance, veteran records all pertain to my Texas address which is a mail forwarding address that sends my mail where ever I happen to be at the time in the USA, I pay extra for this service. Until I am rich enough to by land and live in California I remain a Texas resident. Please further note that I am a Low Income Veteran Administration Pension recipient of \$818.00 a month on which I am currently living. Out of this income I pay \$397.09 each month for my motor home which I remodeled and turned into my office and opened my business two years ago in July 2002 in an attempt to better myself and gain access to more economic resources to be used to pay off student loans, motor home loans, and personal loans from my parents and buy land to build a nice house near the Pacific Ocean in California somewhere north of Santa Barbara and south of Monterey. My company that I opened nearly two years ago is the Independent I.T. Consulting company and the website is www.IndITConsulting.com. My income remains low and I have made only a few dollars in the last two years that I am operating my small I.T. business. All my income is always reported to the Veteran Administration because based on my income my future Low Income Veteran Pension eligibility is determined. After I make my motor home monthly payment of \$397.09 I have very little money left to buy food, motor home insurance, auto parts, gasoline, electricity and personal items. As a result of me not being a California resident and my current low income status please excuse me from this frivolous order to register my motor home in California and any consequences arising from the issuance of the unwarranted fix it ticket based on CVC: 4000a section of the California Vehicle Code. As a courtesy I submitted documents proving these facts to the Butte County Traffic Court system in Chico California on Oleander street, yet they persisted on finding me guilty anyway. In closing I don't live in California. I am including a copy of my Income History, which I update regularly on my website under my resume web page. Thank you.
