Dear VECTORS of CHICO CA. (Steve Longoria),

As of today 17.DEC.2005 I am leaving the Veteran House on Rio Lindo Ave in Chico California.

As we discussed, the reasons for my departure is that I am not among my peers here at the Vectors Veteran House in Chico CALIFORNIA and that I am concerned about my safety with respect to petty arguments leading to verbal abuses which could lead to physical fights between myself and tenants living here.

As you may already know, my assessment is that I am living here with lightly supervised older Veterans at this facility who have various drug abuse, alcohol abuse and/or criminal histories whom are paroled in Chico. They are set in their ways and as a result personality conflicts between myself and a few persons living at this facility developed in a very short amount of time. Namely a 50 year old person "Jerry" was very territorial about the facility kitchen and lightly verbally abusive towards me which I firmly put a stop to today that led to "Jerry" providing a opportunity for a fist fight which I declined by walking away from the kitchen to the living room to where "L" a friend of "Jerry" followed me from the kitchen and verbally abused me in front of another veteran providing me with a second opportunity for a fist fight within 5 minutes of each other that I also declined to fight the hardened Veteran because I would have more to loose from any altercation than the Veteran making the verbal abusive advances towards me.

I am leaving the Vectors House for the safety of "any other" housing facility where I believe less contentious living conditions will probably exist, I do not believe or expect to have any personality conflicts with even the most difficult tenants there because I expect that much closer supervision will exist from the administrators administering the housing programs.

As a result of my move, and because VECTORS is here to HELP veterans, and I am a Veteran needing help, I am asking for a refund of the unused portion of my \$150 rent for the month of December 2005 in addition to the \$17.98 receipt that I am turning in for my purchase of an authorized door lock and tools to install it from K-mart which I installed on my door.
