CHIEF COMPLAINT: Head injury.

HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS: This is a 38-year-old male who came into the Emergency Department today complaining of an alleged assault. He states that he was downtown in the park. He states that a homeless person had a chain and hit him on the back of the head with his chain. He did not lose consciousness, he remembered the entire event. He complained of some discomfort where he was hit but denies significant headache, no dizziness, no blurry vision, no hearing deficits. No vomiting, no abdominal discomfort, no numbness, tingling or weakness in the arms or legs. No neck pain, no sternum pain or any other problems. He complained that he noticed that he began to develop a little swelling in the back of his head. For this reason and the fact that he wanted to press charges, he came here to the ED for evaluation. By the time he came here the swelling and discomfort had resolved. He did not have any acute complaints.

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REVIEW OF SYSTEMS: CONSTITUTIONAL: No fever, chills, weakness or fatigue. NEUROLOGICAL: No headache, dizziness, blurred vision, no numbness or weakness in the extremities. No confusion or disorientation. No loss of consciousness. CARDIOVASCULAR: No chest pain, palpitations or syncope. RESPIRATORY: No cough, shortness of breath or wheeze. GASTROINTESTINAL: No abdominal pain, nausea or vomiting. GENITOURINARY: No painful urination. SKIN: No rash. MUSCULOSKELETAL: No back pain or neck pain, no extremity pain. ENT: No nose stuffiness or sore throat.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION: GENERAL: This patient looked very well. He did not appear to be in any distress. VITAL SIGNS: Temperature 37.1, heart rate 118, respirations 20, blood pressure 142/75, oxygen saturation 96% on room air. HEENT: Head; there were no contusions, abrasions, lacerations, hematomas or any areas of swelling. I asked him where he was struck, he pointed to the occipital region of his scalp. When I palpated it there was no swelling, there was no crepitus. There are no breaks in the skin and there were no areas of tenderness. Eyes: Pupils are
